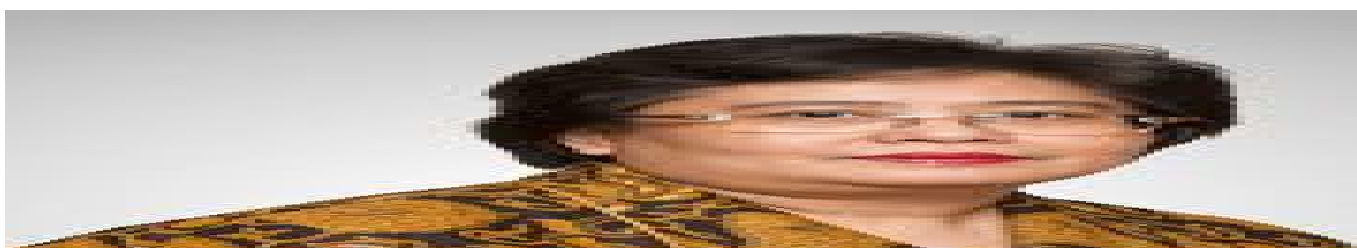
Java/Bali, Indonesia: Enago in collaboration with five of the top universities across Indonesia organized a series of interactive workshops for early-career researchers in the country. The host universities comprised University of Indonesia (UI), Bogor Agricultural University (IPB), Gadjah Mada University (UGM), Udayana University, and BINUS University. **The registration activity elicited an overwhelming response of over 2400 interested researchers from around 15 universities!**



The workshop topics ranged from importance of research and publication ethics and

best practices in selecting target journals to presenting in international conferences and importance of peer networking. Each session began with a brief discussion on the publication landscape and the citation potential of research papers written by Indonesian authors.

“This series of workshops enabled our Indonesian audience to understand the different aspects involved in the publication cycle, including answers to questions like how to prepare a manuscript, what are the ethical issues to keep in mind, what is the importance of attending academic conferences, and how to revise a manuscript based on referee feedback. 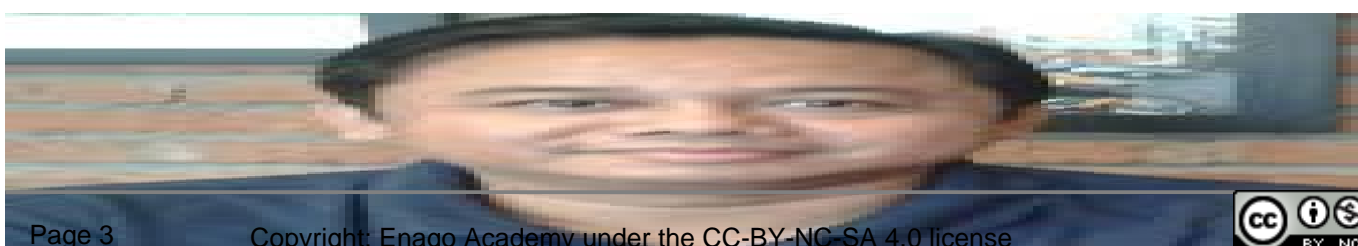
