How Do You Evaluate the Quality of a Research Article?



- Published in a peer-reviewed journal or a refereed source
- Good journal metrics (primarily SJR/Clarivate IF)



- Background of the author (affiliation, research profile, other publications, etc.)



- Novel idea/addresses an important research gap
- Recent and relevant OR slightly older and well-cited
- Significant outcome with clear benefits to society/industry
