Speak clearly and slowly

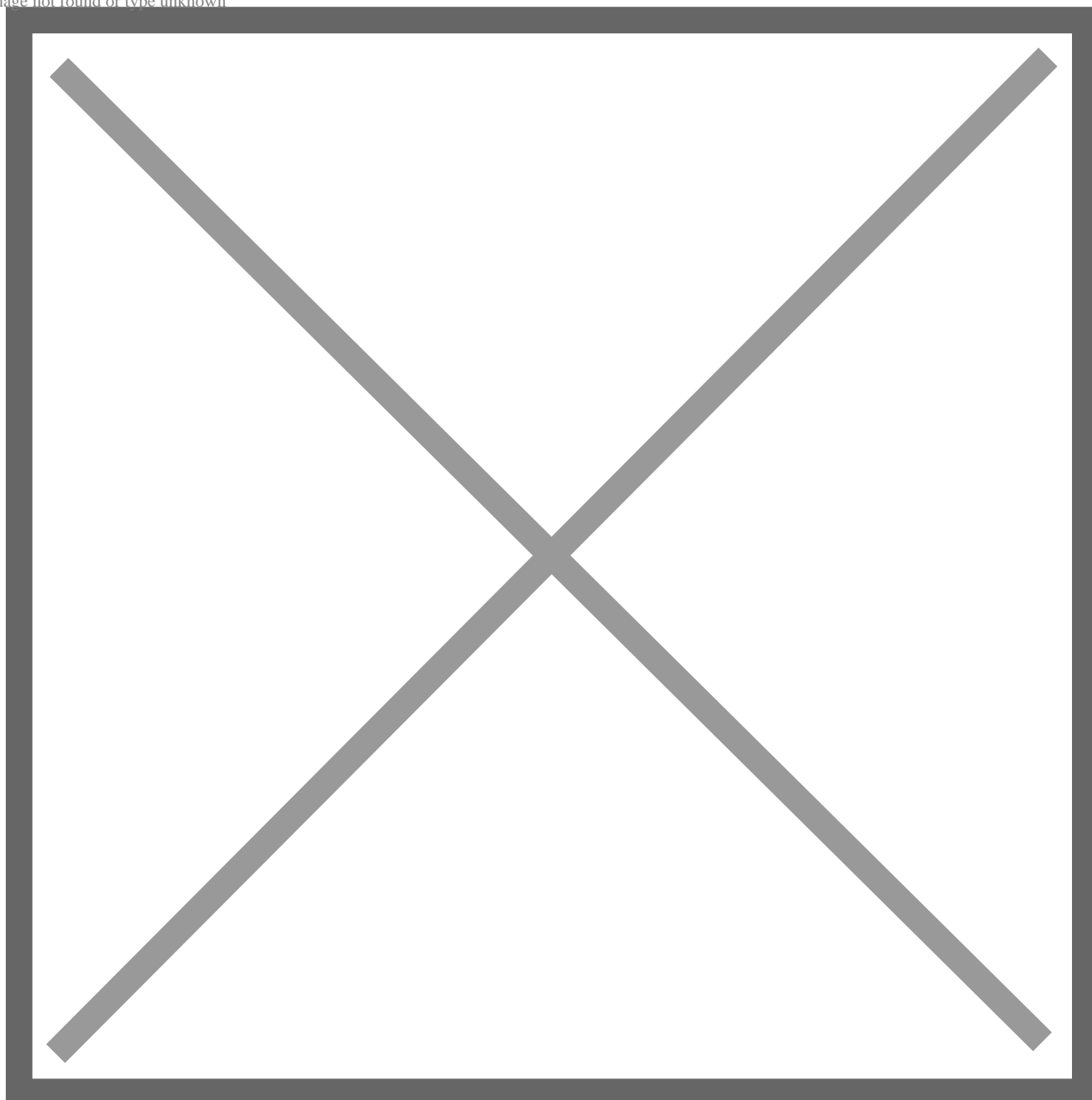
Be well informed about the recent trends in the field of your research
