

Qualitative Research Versus Quantitative Research

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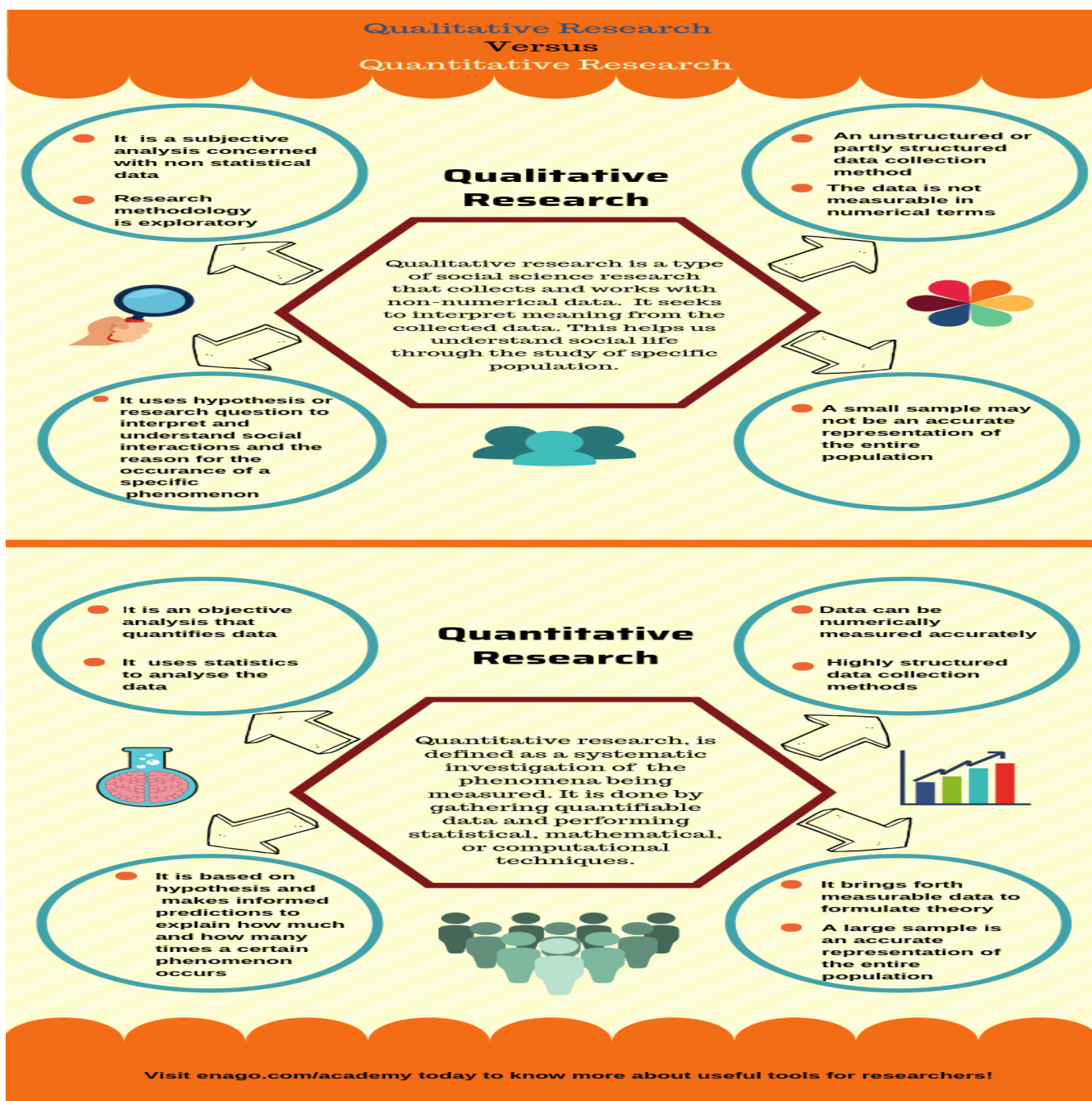

The approach depends on the specific area of interest and is broadly identified as Qualitative research and Quantitative research.
