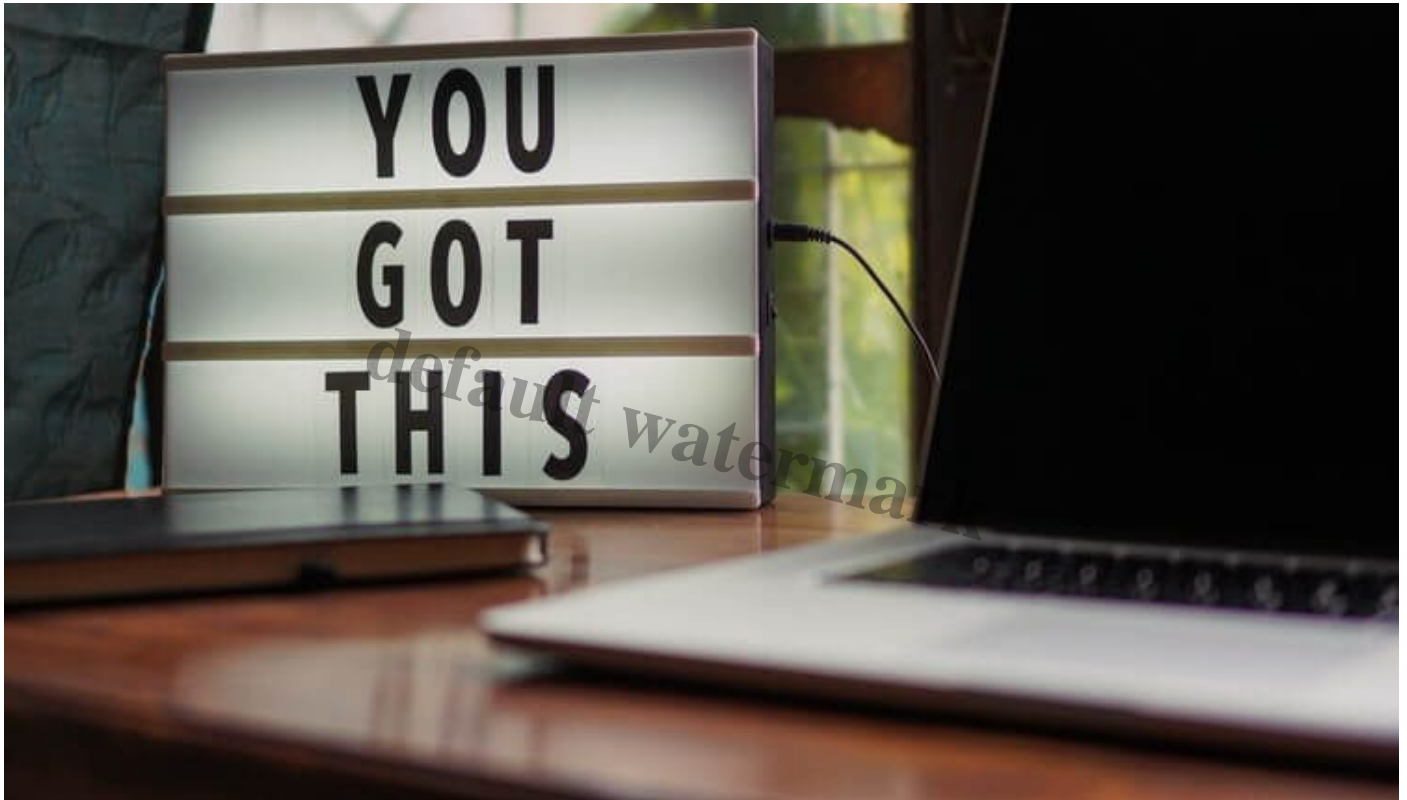

Northern Ireland. Figures released in late 2013 by NISRA<sup>2</sup> show the number of people aged 65 and over are projected to increase by 25% from 273,000 to 344,000 by 2022. By 2022 the over 65s will represent 18% of the total population which is an increase of 3p.p from 2012. Consequently the oldest old, aged 85 and over will rise from 33,000 to 48,000 (an increase of almost 50%).
