

TIPS FOR WRITING A GOOD REVIEW ARTICLE



Conduct a thorough literature survey.



Include a title, abstract, index, introduction, corpus, bibliography, and appendices (if needed) in your review article.



Choose a well-defined topic and draft the review keeping in mind your target audience.



Use reference management tools (e.g., Mendeley Desktop) to cite published work and save time.



Maintain good structure and flow.



Review and highlight the latest and most-cited research.



Avoid plagiarism by explaining published literature to your target audience in your own words.



Present a detailed analysis of the research work undertaken in a particular area.



Identify strengths and weaknesses, refrain from bias, and cite accurately.



In the summary section, identify topics/ideas that need further investigation.
